

Ready for Recovery: New Hampshire Weatherization Program's Ramp-Up

September 25, 2009

This report summarizes the actions New Hampshire weatherization providers had taken as of August 12 in anticipation of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act ramp-up of the state's Weatherization Assistance Program. The table below outlines how weatherization providers in the state have increased staff and spending on major equipment primarily using other weatherization funding.

New Hampshire Readiness Highlights:

- 88 staff and contractor jobs created;
- 14 US-made vehicles purchased;

- 5 additional Insulation machines purchased.
