

## **SLCAP Weatherization Training Plan - T&TA**

July 2008

Training at SLCAP Weatherization Program will take place in three forms. The first is trainings such as those provided by the national or regional conference and those provided through the State Energy office, such as auditor, pressure diagnostics, etc. All possible staff will be sent to these trainings as appropriate and as funding allows.

Additional trainings are provided by SLCAP staff who have been certified as trainers. Such programs as Lead Safe Weatherization and Mold and Moisture Health Education\* will be taught in-house by certified trainers.

At this time SLCAP has one staff certified as a trainer in Lead Safe Weatherization. New staff members are trained as soon as possible, and before they have completed their 6 month probation. Additionally, the trainers plan a semi-annual refresher course on Lead Safe Weatherization. These trainings have been made available to other agencies as well.

Further training has been and will continue to be procured through the appropriate agencies as needed to meet insurance and code requirements, such as those listed below:

General Contractor - regularly updated  
S350 Furnace Contractor - regularly updated  
Lead Safe Weatherization/Refresher (18 Staff)  
Energy Auditing (1 Staff)  
Furnace Training (5 Staff)  
Coordinator Meetings (2 Each Meeting)  
Mold, Mildew & Ventilation (18)
